- The Community Hub are looking at providing prescription deliveries again. Lucy (Community Resilience Coordinator) has been in talks with pharmacies and residents on the Ryde Community Hub vulnerable list, to assess demand and how to redeliver the service.
- Telephone Support Service is running well and is very popular. Aspire Ryde are hoping to run this from ARCH, as well as offering telephone support on Christmas day.
- Mental Health support – Most Mental Health services are in Newport and this is not always easy for people to get to.
