### Report on the options for producing a Housing Needs Survey for Ryde

A housing needs survey for Ryde is a locally produced survey of housing requirements of the residents already living in the Ryde area. The survey also includes details of future requirements up to 5 years ahead. The questions should be designed to complement the latest Isle of Wight Housing Needs Assessment and drill down into the more personal and "place" based information which is too detailed for the HNA. In future, it would be more useful to produce this Housing Needs Survey prior to the publishing of the Isle of Wight Council's Housing Needs Assessment then the findings can be inform the HNA.

There are several ways to carry out a survey and each has differing success in getting sufficient replies to make the survey credible. A list of the survey options is shown below:

- 1. **Mailshot** to every household with return envelopes and the promise of a prize. This will give the greatest returns but is expensive. For example, there are between 10,000 and 12,000 homes in Ryde and the postage cost for all households would be between £13,600 and £16,320.
- 2. Online Survey via survey monkey or other online survey company. This would need to be heavily advertised to get the number of responses needed and the information would be less reliable as there would be no certainty that the response was from a Ryde resident or that there were not more than 1 response from each household.
- 3. In Person Survey via house to house interview. This is expensive and time consuming although there would be a high degree of accuracy with the data. There may be a problem getting enough data due to empty houses at the time of the visit.

The benefits of such a survey are that the Ryde area can, to various degrees of accuracy, identify the kind of housing required in the future in Ryde. Information such as house size or whether the housing needs to be social housing and not just affordable are all important aspects of the survey and the more replies you can get the more credible the survey information is.

Ryde has maybe missed the boat when it comes to this survey influencing the New Draft Island Planning Strategy but, given the size of the survey if there were a large number of replies, it would be hard for the IW Council to ignore it.
