Infrastructure Plan for Ryde

At a meeting of Ryde Town Council held on 2nd December, it was unanimously agreed that I should write to you, calling upon you to produce, as a matter of urgency and in the interest of public safety, a detailed infrastructure plan for the whole of Ryde. Such a plan is necessary because of the large number of new developments planned for Ryde, which have infrastructure implications for the whole town. We are particularly concerned about road infrastructure, but the plan should also cover all physical and social infrastructure. All parties would be required to consult the plan when reviewing developments for which permission has already been given and when assessing new applications.

This call for action mirrors the approach taken by Ryde Town Council in our Position Statement and is issued in order to reinforce the actions outlined in section 8 (Infrastructure)

Given the latest development at Nicholson Road and the imminent prospect of a further 465 houses coming forward at West Acre Park, I look forward to a prompt response from the IW Council with regard to the infrastructure issues highlighted above.
